The School of Management offers the Bachelor of Business Administration Program (BBA) in any of the eight majors in Accounting, Entrepreneurship and Innovation Management, Finance, General Business, International Business, Marketing, Organizational Behavior and Human Resource Management, and Operations and Supply Chain Management. Admission to a BBA program requires:

- Successful completion of the following 11 pre-business courses (BUS 110, 115, 250; ACC 201, 202; SCM 211; ECN 201, 202; MTH 111; ENG/COM 338; PSY 100 or SOC 100) or their transfer equivalents;
- At least a 2.2 overall grade point average; and
- Attendance at the required orientation session.
