Courses with a 1.0 grade will transfer within an associate degree; however, it cannot fulfill SHU major requirements. • SHU will accept up to 6 semester hours of developmental credit and up to 4 semester hours of physical education courses within a bachelor's degree. • HFC students transferring without an associate degree will be evaluated on a case -by -case basis. • Transfer credit may be awarded for military, CLEP and professional licensure.
