Subject: Increase in TIF funding amount

During the Winter 2016 TIF funding cycle, the Infrastructure Fund allocated \$204,000 for a firewall, internet routers, core switches, and server farm switches. The following is what was proposed.

Proposed Items	Cost
1 Cisco MX 6000 Firewall & 2 Cisco 4431 Internet Routers	\$ 89,000
2 Cisco 4500 Core Switch with 3 2960x Server Farm Switches	\$115,000
Total	\$204,000

During the specification process, it became clear that the proposed equipment would not meet the growing technology needs of the college. As a result, ITS began to look at newer technology that is more robust, expandable, and highly available. Specifications were developed and bids released for the following equipment. The resulting bids had a total cost greater than the amount allocated from the Infrastructure fund.

The equipment specified and bid is as follows:

2 Cisco 4431 Internet Gateway Routers	\$ 23,510
2 Cisco Catalyst 4500-X 40 Port 10G with 3 Catalyst 2960-X 48 GigE Server Farm Switches	\$110,238
Total	\$317,132

Therefore, I am requesting an additional allocation from the Infrastructure Fund of **\$113,132** during the Fall 2016 TIF cycle.
