1. **Please describe your project as specifically as possible. Include, but do not limit yourself to, answers to these questions:**

- a. **What do you propose to do?**

There are two parts to this project.

1. To equip H 218 with technology and student seating for a collaborative and flexible classroom that can have multiple uses (e.g. group work, exercise presentations, and exercise classes). Currently, H 218 is used as a Graphic Design classroom. The Graphic Design lab will move to the photography lab located in the Fine Arts building. Division funds will be used to relocate the graphics lab to the photography lab.

2. To develop an exercise science laboratory to support Fitness Leadership, Wellness, Stress Management, and Nutrition classes.

- b. **Why do you propose to do this?**

The establishment of this classroom and laboratory will provide an optimal learning environment for students who take certain classes in Health and Physical Education. Additionally, students will be provided with laboratory experiences that will strengthen their learning and make them more marketable employees and students.

2. **How many unique students will be served each academic year (Fall through Summer) by your project? "Unique students" refers to unduplicated headcount. Provide detail (course numbers, titles, and enrollments, for example).**

1) Fall 2015, (see appendix - fall 2015 enrollment statistics) we offered 10 sections of HPE 142 – Advanced First Aid with a 97.5% enrollment. Advanced First Aid classes can only be offered in H 204 because the class needs specific equipment. The creation of this new classroom in H 218 would allow us to move non-first aid class from H 204 to H 218 freeing up space to offer approximately 6 – 8 additional First Aid classes. (6 X 24 = 144)

2) The division has difficulty finding classroom space to offer HPE/HPEA classes to meet the demand (see appendix – fall 2015 enrollment statistics). There is a need for additional Nutrition (HPE 153, 158, and 253), Wellness (HPE 140 and 141), and Stress Management (HPE 155) classes. Instructors have to teach around campus (Liberal Arts and Fine Arts Buildings) which makes it difficult to transport the necessary equipment for teaching the class appropriately. Offering current classes and increasing course offerings will increase head count. (14 X 24 = 336)

3) Due to space limitations, HPE 122 – Yoga is offered in the gymnasium. This is a less than an ideal space for yoga because of the open balcony and activity in and out of the gymnasium. We are designing the classroom so that it could be used for a Yoga or Pilates class. (Head count included in #2 above)

4) Finally, there is a need for additional space for the athletic teams to meet. The Graphic Design classroom does not work because of the computers. This new classroom design will allow for teams to meet when classes are not in session.

The total cost of the project is \$51,269 with classroom technology and equipment costing \$31,988 and laboratory equipment costing \$19,281. Specific costs are detailed in the appendix.

Division funds will cover cost for maintenance and laboratory supplies.

Since the classroom was used as a computer lab, there is adequate infrastructure for the technology to be changed in the classroom.

Who, specifically, will do the installation?

The current computer lab equipment will be removed by Information Technology Services. Installation has been included in the costs of the new equipment.

- c. **How will equipment purchases be secured?**

Classroom will be locked with a card reader door lock and lockdowns have been included in the equipment purchase.

5. **How, specifically, will you determine the success or shortcomings of your project?**

The success of the use of the student funded TIF will be measured by the students receiving a more collaborative and experiential learning environment, by having more classes available to students in areas of interest, and providing students with exposure to equipment and knowledge they will be expected to know when entering the work environment. Specifically, to measure these outcomes, we can evaluate enrollment over several semesters and survey instructors/students on their experience in the classroom.
